### Suggested Steps in Preparing to Implement this New Law

1. Obtain a copy of your district's adopted policy.
2. Determine the contact person who oversees your district's Policy Against Bullying and Harassment.
3. Set up meetings and trainings to prepare bus drivers for implementing their part in the district's new policy.
4. Create a contact list for bus drivers which includes the designee or contact person at each school in regards to the policy prohibiting bullying and harassment.
5. Obtain copies of reporting forms for your district
